Protect Your Waters from Aquatic Invasive Species

A Guide for Powerboaters and Motorized Watercraft

Clean ALL SURFACES THAT TOUCH WATER, including boat hull, live wells, bilge, engine, gear, trailer, water toys & even the back of the towing vehicle.

CLEAN

Dispose of water, dirt, mud, plant matter or other debris in a trash can or well above the high water line and away from storm drains.

Flush running engine with hose water for 5 minutes to replace any potentially contaminated water with fresh tapwater.

DRAIN

Remove plug & drain water from bilge, live wells & all compartments. Use a sponge to remove any moisture from low points of the watercraft. Lower engine outdrive AFTER cleaning for 15 minutes to drain cooling system.

DRY

With plug removed, dry watercraft, compartments & gear for at least 7 days in the summer (30 days in winter) before launching in a different fresh waterbody.
